THE BREWSTER TRUST: Football Holiday Camp 2014



The Football Holiday Camp is back for the 4th year; THE BREWSTER TRUST presents - within its strategic approach - a programme with proven standards as well as new features. The Football Holiday Camp 2014 is again football for everyone, for girls, boys, children with disabilities and for adults. It will take place from 21st July to 15th August 2014 as a varying programme on weekdays for a total of four weeks; venue is again Queen's College, Husbands, St. James.

Programme & age groups

Age group: 5 – 14 years (born 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 & 2009)

- Group A: Monday, 21st July to Friday, 1st August 2014, weekdays only, 9.00 am 3.30 pm
- Group B: Monday, 4th August to Friday, 15th August 2014, weekdays only, 9.00 am 3.30 pm



Age group: 15+ (born after 2000)

• Monday, 28th July to Friday, 8th August 2014, weekdays only, 4.30 pm to 7.30 pm

<u>Coaches</u>

Interested coaches have the opportunity to register for the camp, assigned to individual ages and individual weeks to assist and shadow the charity's coaching team.

Some insights

THE BREWSTER TRUST developed a special meal plan with typical football food like rice, pasta, vegetables or salads and juices for lunch with fruit breaks between the sessions or healthy snacks for the evening sessions. Camp Partner POWERade takes care of isotonic beverages; bottle filling stations and water coolers will be available in the camp village. For every registered participant THE BREWSTER TRUST is contracting insurance cover with a special sport package for the duration of the camp supported by UNITED Insurance Co. Ltd. All coaches are familiar with First Aid; the further medical facility consists of a special ambulance service with camp partner Island Care and present physiotherapists of REHABWORKS, Health Fitness & Performance Centre.

Every participant receives a football kit with shirt, shorts, socks and shinpads – all supplied by THE BREWSTER TRUST in close co-operation with PUMA.

Two specials

Similar to the "Boots Campaign 2013" football boots will be available as well, again in close cooperation with camp partner PUMA.

Besides the sessions on the field THE BREWSTER TRUST will offer classroom sessions with football as part of general literacy, indoor Futsal sessions, teaching the rules and laws of football and an UNICEF workshop "Keeping Healthy".

Registration & fees

Spaces are limited, first come, first served. The registration fee is BDS\$ 50.00 with a refund of BDS\$ 20.00 on full participation. THE BREWSTER TRUST is encouraging participation as part of the programme as well as rewarding good attendance.
