### Alexandra get football gear

THE FOOTBALLERS of Alexandra School now have the football equipment they need to improve their skills.

During a presentation at the school last week, assistant secretary of the Barbados Secondary Schools' Football League, Tricia Forde, told **NATIONSPORT** the contribution was part of the initiative being undertaken by the association to grow the sport.

"It is something we have been trying to do to help develop football in Barbados and give opportunity through the sponsorship of Coca-Cola and . . . Massy Insurance," she said.

Forde identified Ellerslie Secondary, Combermere, Alexandra and The St Michael School as the beneficiaries of the donations that included footballs and goal bars.
