



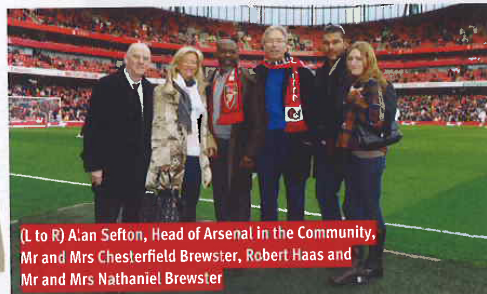

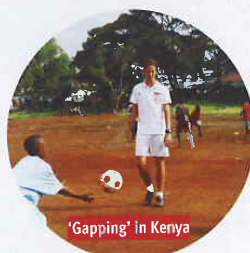


GAP YEAR INTERNSHIP COMMUNITY COACHES MOZAMBIQUE PLACEMENT

The Brewster Trust, founded in 2010, is a registered charity in Barbados. The Trust has signed a three-year commitment to support the Arsenal in the Community Gap Year Internship Programme.

In April 2010, Alan Sefton, Head of Arsenal in the Community and John Olaleye, Gap Year co-ordinator, delivered a coach education programme for The Brewster Trust at the University of the West Indies, Barbados. The development of sports based social inclusion initiatives to be delivered by coaches is the key driver in this programme as the Trust's general mission is to promote, develop and improve football in Barbados with the aim of creating opportunities at all levels, but especially for the

youth. The founders of the Charity, Chesterfield Brewster and his son, Nathaniel, are dedicated to assist and support the development of football in Barbados. One objective



is to have qualified and experienced personnel in football willing to share their knowledge – Arsenal's approach fits perfectly with this philosophy. The Brewster Foundation has also agreed to support the Gap Year Internship

programme at our other projects in Kenya, Mozambique and Israel and this will be replicated in Barbados. The Brewster Trust is working on a lasting structure for Barbados football including club development, dedicated pitches, infrastructure, functional equipment, facilities and attractive leagues covering all age groups to allow competition in a full football season. Individuals should be given a fair chance to participate, to have fun and have the opportunity to represent their school, team, club or even country. It's obvious this requires the cooperation with national and international football stakeholders – just like Arsenal FC through Arsenal in the Community and the Gap Year Programme.
